Night work in the trenches

A gasket blew on 48" fiberglass irrigation pipe (installed by others). This project was very important to repair right away so 1,200 acres of crops could be saved.

The call came in Friday at noon. Equipment and crew were mobilized by 3:00 PM. We worked late Friday night and early Saturday morning until 6:00 AM Sunday morning.
